7. Plug your eReader into your computer with a USB cable. If the following screen automatically appears, click "Authorize Device" and continue to step 9. If it does not appear, proceed to step 8.

8. Find your eReader under "Devices" in the left pane of Adobe Digital Editions. Click the settings icon and then "Authorize Device..." to authorize your eReader to download eBooks.



9. From the Internet, go to the library's web site (<u>www.fmb.lib.fl.us</u>) and select "eBooks" at the top of the page to browse the library's eBook catalog.



10. Search for a title by keyword (title, author, or subject) or genre (romance, mystery, etc.). Click on the cover of any book you would like to download or learn more about.



11. When you find an eBook that you would like to download, select "Borrow". If the eBook is currently checked out, there will be an option to "Place a Hold" to join the waiting list. If you place a hold, you will receive an e-mail when the book is available.



12. If you haven't signed in to the eBook catalog already, sign in now at the prompt with your library card number and PIN number.

13. To download the eBook, select "Download", check "EPUB eBook", and then select "Confirm & Download". In your browser, find the downloaded file and select "Open" (each web browser varies slightly). You should automatically be taken to Adobe Digital Editions.



The Host Stephenie Meyer 14. Make sure that your eReader is plugged into your computer. From Adobe Digital Editions, select the eBook that you downloaded. Click, hold, and drag the eBook to your eReader which should appear under "Devices" in the left pane.



15. Your book is now ready to read on your eReader! If you would like to return your eBook before the lending period expires, right click on the eBook in Adobe Digital editions and select "Return Borrowed Item".
